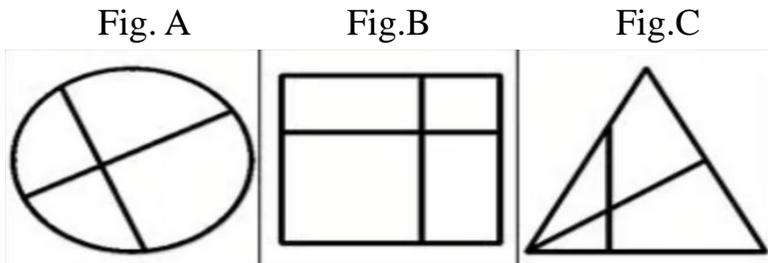

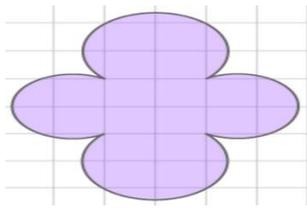

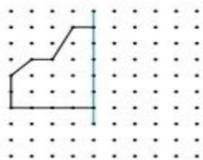

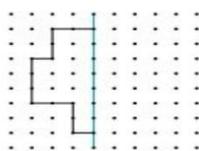

27. A school ground is of length 47m and width 29m. On the same ground a badminton court is marked with width 16m and length 24m. Find the area of remaining portion of the ground.

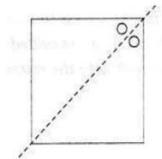
28. Create your own artwork or pattern or drawing using only compass.
